While we strive to ensure our on-farm euthanasia methods are compliant and meet accepted industry standards, we accept people may find this practice distressing. It is however standard procedure for any egg laying farm to euthanise spent hens at the end of their laying cycle to maintain manageable hen populations.

In the wake of community concerns, we have committed to reviewing and improving our practices and are currently investigating custom-built technology to improve our on-farm facilities.

The RSPCA WA has not laid any charges in relation to our population management practices and has agreed to work with us to ensure our new equipment meets industry best practice.

Earlier this month an independent auditor also completed an inspection of our farm and confirmed our Quality Assurance Certification.
